Quality issue / initial problem

If issues at home are not effectively identified for a psychiatric inpatient then discharge home can be prevented or delayed.

Specific aim

Early assessment of home living conditions to more quickly identify and resolve barriers to discharge.

Effects of change

Early identification of required remedial work can speed up discharge. Looking to incorporate into SCAMPER, TRAK and seek CMHT involvement.

Lessons learned and message for others

Perseverance required, takes much more time to do even small things.

Small changes can make a big difference.
